

Giant Greenhouse Complex Inaugurated in DPRK

In mid-March, a world-leading vegetable production complex was completed and went into operation in the Kangdong area of Pyongyang, the capital city of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea.

The Kangdong Greenhouse Complex is the third of its kind in the country after the large-scale greenhouse farms in Jungphyong (inaugurated in December 2019) and Ryonpho (inaugurated in October 2022).

It is a new-generation vegetable producer whose size and production capacity are much bigger and more developed than the Ryonpho Greenhouse Farm.

Equipped with highly intensive, optimized and smart production lines, including a cylindrical vegetable cultivation greenhouse and dome-shaped glass hydroponic greenhouse, the complex will produce and supply various species of vegetables to the citizens of the capital city.
