

Respected Comrade Kim Jong Un Sends Wreath to Liberation Tower





Pyongyang, August 16 (KCNA) -- **Kim Jong Un**, general secretary of the Workers' Party of Korea and president of the State Affairs of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea, sent a wreath to the Liberation Tower on August 15, the 78th anniversary of Korea's liberation.

The guards of honor of the Korean People's Army lined up before the tower.

Upon authorization, Ri II Hwan, member of the Political Bureau and secretary of the Central Committee of the Workers' Party of Korea, placed the wreath from the respected Comrade **Kim Jong Un** at the tower.
