It is characteristic in that it not only reflects the life sentiments and aspirations of the local people but also is diverse in its form and rich in its movements.

The folk dances including the Unryul Mask Dance are played among the local people thanks to the policy of the Workers' Party of Korea and the state on the conservation of national cultural heritage.
